**Call To Action 20/30 is an inclusive community of reform-minded Catholics in our 20s and 30s.**

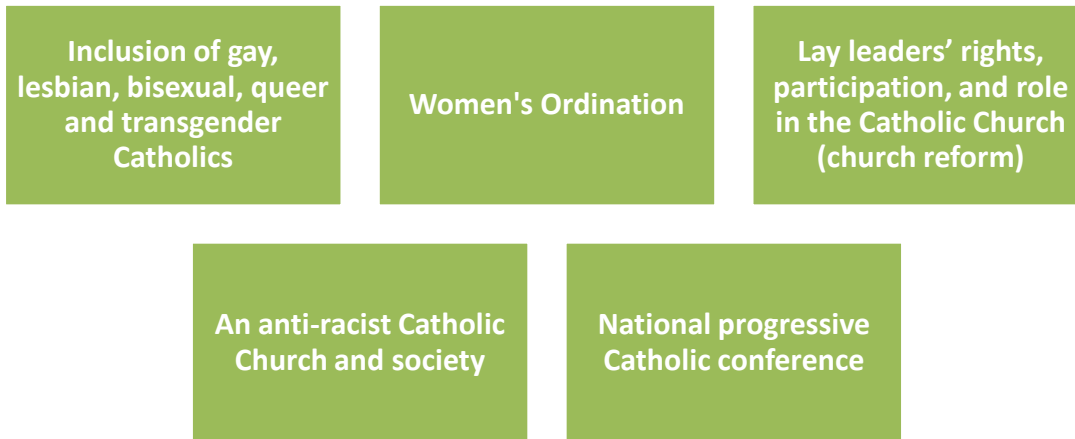

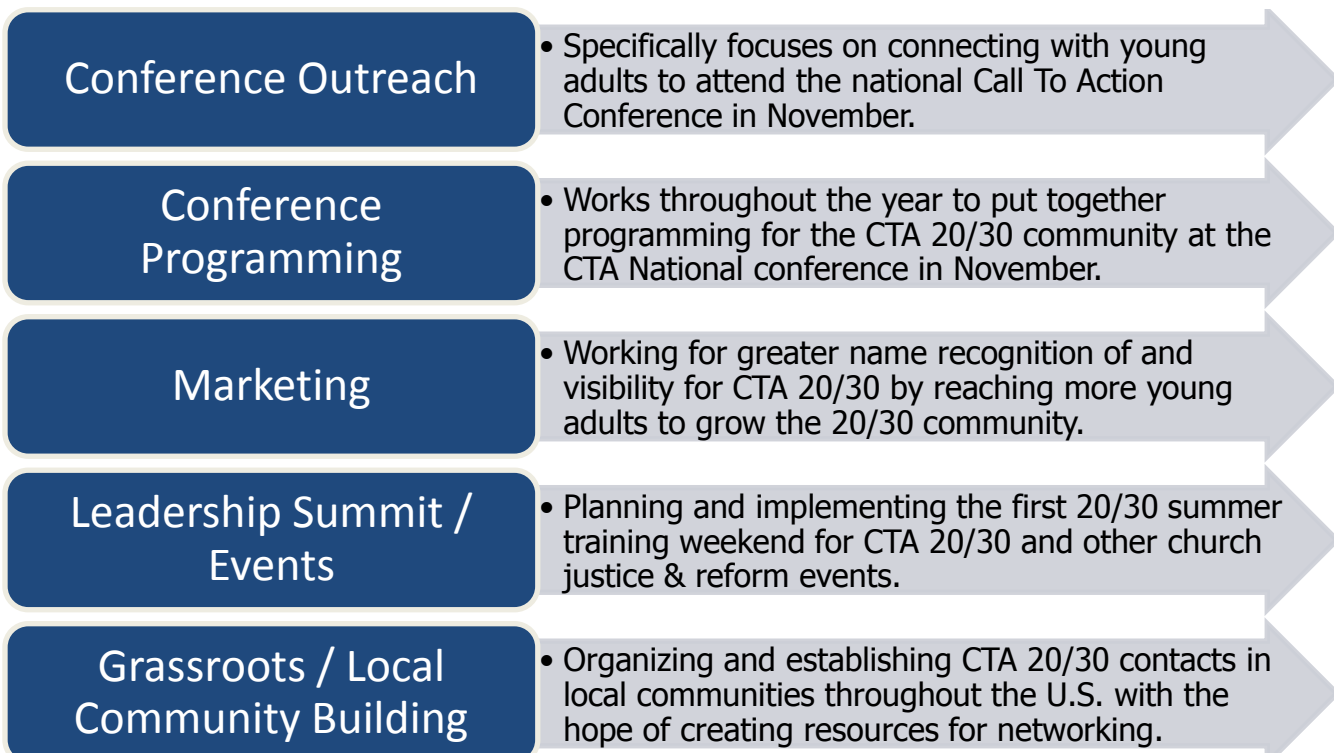
