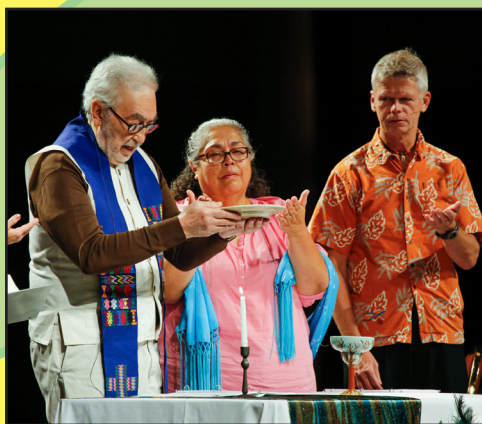
I believe in the power and love of our Church.
